itinerant space is a PGR-founded and PGR-run scholarly platform using peer review to support the research of PGR students at RCA.

itinerant space welcomes applications from the RCA PGR community to become members of the peer review panel.

As a student-led research publication, *itinerant space* supports the development of practical skills in research publishing for RCA PGRs. Through membership of its Peer Review Panel, the journal offers doctoral researchers opportunity to explore the pedagogical value of peer review processes and to critically engage with its application in academic publishing.

itinerant space is an experimental evolving platform on which each issue is a contested event in an iterative process. For each issue of *itinerant space*, themes emerge out of the set of contributions the journal's peer review process curates. It is important to note that change is a product of negotiation by the peer review panel. The changes proposed may not be immediately apparent to all, nor take anticipated forms. As the journal evolves, our peer review panel will learn and become more skilled in the peer review process. A process that will define what the journal is.
